

## OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Crossroads is a fully TEA accredited high school. Two graduation ceremonies are held each school year.
- Crossroads High School is a “School of Choice.” Students are required to submit an application and participate in an interview process to be allowed to attend.
- Students must provide their own transportation to and from Crossroads High School each day.
- Crossroads school hours are different from the regular high school hours, but we follow the Burleson ISD calendar.
- Crossroads High School follows all BISD dress codes, policies, and procedures which can be found in the BISD Student and Parent Handbook.
- Once accepted to Crossroads High School, students are expected to graduate from Crossroads or find another avenue outside the BISD to complete their education.

### DIRECTIONS TO CROSSROADS HIGH SCHOOL

**From I-35:** Exit Hwy 174 (Wilshire Blvd.), continue west on Wilshire about 1 mile to the intersection of Gardens and Wilshire. Turn left on Gardens, drive about 1/2 mile to Pleasant Manor. Turn left on Pleasant Manor...continue until it dead ends. Building will be on the right.

**From Cleburne/Joshua:** Take Hwy 174, the second light after Wal-Mart will be Gardens Dr. Turn right on Gardens Dr., drive about 1/2 mile to Pleasant Manor. Turn left on Pleasant Manor...continue until it dead ends. Building will be on the right.

## Ready to Graduate?

- Are you ready to graduate?
- Have you fallen behind in your credits?
- Do you ask yourself, “Why Try?”

If you answered “Yes” to any of these questions, perhaps you should apply to attend Crossroads High School.

Crossroads is an alternative Education Program serving students in the Burleson ISD who are at-risk of not graduating from high school. We serve students who are ready to “Cross That Finish Line” of graduation.

Students who attend Crossroads High School have the opportunity to move toward graduation in an accelerated manner, through non-traditional instructional methods.



## Enrollment Requirements

We require prospective students to apply for enrollment at Crossroads High School. Applications can be obtained from Crossroads High School, on the Burleson ISD website, or from Burleson High School or Centennial High School.

Applications are reviewed for the following criteria:

- Must be a resident of Burleson, TX (residing in the BISSD boundaries) and currently enrolled in BHS or CHS
- Must be at least 17 years of age during the first semester of attendance at Crossroads
- Must have completed at least 5-10 credits toward graduation
- Must meet one of the following “At-Risk” criteria:
  - Did not pass a semester in a core class, any part of the STAAR-EOC test, or has failed a grade level;
  - Is pregnant or a parent;
  - Has been placed in a DAEP (RTDC) or has been expelled in the preceding or current school year;
  - Is currently on probation, parole, or other conditional release;
  - Was reported for dropping out of school;
  - Is homeless; or
  - Resides, in the preceding or current school year, in a residential placement facility.
- Application must include:
  - Student’s own handwriting,
  - Recommendation from counselor, judge, administrator, etc...
  - Current transcript

## Interviews

Interviews are scheduled according to space availability, student’s age (older students are a greater consideration), student needs/ extenuating circumstance, and number of credits completed (higher number of credits completed are given priority.)

- Interviews will include the student and a parent or guardian.
- The disposition of the student toward wanting to graduate will be taken into consideration.
- Interviews last about an hour.
- Decisions may or may not be made at the time of the interview. Students are generally informed within 48 hours as to whether or not they are accepted to Crossroads.

## Pregnancy & Related Services

Students who are pregnant may attend Crossroads High School and participate in the PRS Program. Specific information about the PRS program will be given at the Crossroads High School interview.

Proof of pregnancy will be required at the time of the interview.
